Background

- **First releases of GTAP consist in 37 sectors**
 - Aggregations of those 37 were available to the public in versions 1 and 2
- **In 1995, the first GTAP classification described 50 sectors (GSEC 1)**
- **In 2001, GSEC 2 described 57 sectors**
- **GSEC 3 describes 65 sectors**
 - ISIC and CPC concordances updated as well

8 More Sectors in GTAP 10

- **Food and agriculture remain the same**
 - 8 and 12, respectively
- **3 more manufactures sectors**
 - Expands former Chemical, Rubber and Plastic products and
 - Machinery and electrical equipment
- **5 more services sectors**
 - Expands former Trade, Other Transport, Other Business, and Government services
 - Lower than initial expectation

Additional manufacturing sectors

- **Former CRP into:**
 - Chemical products
 - Basic pharmaceutical products
 - Rubber and plastic products
- **Former OME into:**
 - Electrical equipment
 - Other machinery

Additional services sectors

- **Former TRD into:**
 - Retail and Wholesale trade;
 - Accommodation, food and services
- **Former OTP into:**
 - Other transport
 - Warehousing and support activities
- **Former OBS into:**
 - Real estate activities
 - Professional, scientific and Administrative and support services
- **Former OSG into:**
 - Public administration and defense; compulsory social security; and activities of extraterritorial organizations and bodies;
 - Education;
 - Human health and social work services
